I agree to ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS that may result from skiing/ riding or use of the facilities at Sugar Mountain Resort. In consideration for this season pass, I hereby RELEASE AND DISCHARGE Sugar Mountain Resort, their employees and agents from all responsibility for injury to person or property arising out of or related to any of the inherent risks of the sport of skiing/snowboarding, including any such risks allegedly caused by the negligence of the ski area operator, its employees or agents. I further agree that the exclusive jurisdiction for any claim asserted against Sugar Mountain Resort is Avery County. Ski Patrol or management has the right to revoke this pass if holder is engaging in careless or reckless skiing/riding and/or inappropriate behavior while on resort property. This pass is subject to all rules and policies of Sugar Mountain Resort. Notify Sugar Mountain Resort, Inc. if pass is lost. NOT TRANSFERABLE!
